Who can't enter?	Katherine Town Council Elected Members,

Who can register for the campaign	Businesses that are only in the Katherine Municipality. All participating businesses must confirm with Katherine Town Council and confirm with Katherine Town Council their participation to contactus@ktc.nt.gov.au. Council will then respond with approval, provide instructions and promotional materials.

Entry Instructions:	To enter, you must making a purchase of \$20.00 or more in one transaction at any participating businesses. Collect your purchase receipt, your receipt can be submitted via Councils website or by emailing contactus@ktc.nt.gov.au Please note your name, contact details must be provided. Prizes are in the form of vouchers and can be redeemed at participating business chosen by winning customer. Vouchers are non-transferable nor are they redeemable for cash.
Claim instructions:	Prize winners will be drawn on the following Tuesdays 5 May, 12 May, 19 May and the 26 of May at 10:00am 2020. Prizes are four (4) x \$200 voucher at chosen participating store. Winning customer can divide the voucher up to four of the participating businesses Katherine Town Council will initiate contact with the winners chosen business/es to organize vouchers.
