13.1 <u>MONTHLY REPORT OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER FOR THE</u> MONTH OF APRIL 2017

That the Chief Executive Officer Report for the month of April 2017 be received and noted.

Mayor Miller noted it was good to see work at the Hot Springs was progressing well.

Deputy Mayor Gazey noted Page 4, 73 service requests made and 58 completed. This followed a similar deficit recorded in the March figures.

CEO noted some of the discrepancy was due to how information was compiled and the process needed to be reviewed. At present Council only have one Ranger and there was an identified need to increase support for that position which would tighten the admin side of Service Request data.

a/DWS commented that some investigations do take longer than a month to resolve, due to the nature of the request.

Alderman Clark thanked a/DWS for the successful Hot Springs traffic measures and noted traffic flow had improved in the area.

Deputy Mayor Gazey noted Page 6, YTD figures column is blank. A figure, even if it's zero should be added.

Mayor Miller noted the Library was doing well with their activities over the *National Library and Information Week*, in particular. Activities have been well attended and appreciated by the attending community.

Deputy Mayor Gazey commented on the low completion rate of Customer Service Satisfaction Surveys.

DCCS stated the forms are on display but the increase in number of visitors in the dry season made it difficult to get customers to fill out the survey. Possible solution might be to use a "post visit" survey system such as Survey Monkey. Post visit surveys often work well as customers have time to recollect on their experiences. DCCS to discuss with VIC Manager.

Alderman Rose – Commented it was good to see visitor numbers increasing early in the dry season and that it boded well for a great season ahead.

Alderman Clark noted the sprinkler repair costs were significantly lower than previous years.

a/DWS stated this was due to the new irrigation system and getting the on/off timings right, which has reduced wilful damage and resulted in cost savings.

Mayor Miller noted that the recently completed line marking seems to have worn off in a matter of weeks.

a/DWS stated that tyre grime has caused the lines to appear as though they have rubbed off. However, the material is still under the tyre "grime". The contractor has completed a 2nd coat on some lines. Those areas now have improved line visibility. a/DSW will continue to monitor the marking.

Alderman Clark commented that repairs to the VIC toilet and shade sails at the park were a constant and reoccurring expense.

Alderman Gazey noted on Page 27 "Padlock and Keys" were for the sportsgrounds security system, which was a multi-layered system, not just simple keys and padlocks.
