5. GENERAL BUSINESS

5.1 Oval 1 lights

KTC advised that their electrical contractor had completed a full audit of the four lighting towers on Oval 1. Each tower has a bank of 9 luminaire fittings. The results of the audit are as follows:

NW tower – 5 lights not working

NE tower – 4 lights not working

SW tower - 3 lights not working

SE tower - 4 lights not working

The style of fittings is now aging, and it is difficult to find replacement parts. The contractor had a small quantity of replacements in stock. The contractor was to arrange to use all available replacements on 1 or 2 towers when a crane was available in the area – expected to be Monday 16th May

5.2 Oval 2 lights

Reports of a bank of light on a tower on the northern side of Oval 2 not working. As these lights are still within their warranty period, Council's contractor will arrange for their removal and checking by the manufacturer. Again this work will be completed by making use of the same crane in conjunction with the Oval 1 works.
