4. BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

4.1 Rear Gate Access:

Query as to why rear gate swipe card doesn't work. Protégé system has only been installed to the front gate at this time.

4.2 Buntine Pavilion Compliance:

A Certificate of Occupancy has been issued for the Buntine Pavilion. A separate Fire Certification is required. KTC is investigating rectification works to bring the non-compliant fire hydrants to compliance. A contingency has been agreed to provide a back up water tanker to the site for the Race meeting.

4.3 Boundary Fence with Golf Club:

This fence has been identified for renewal. Quotes will be sought as per KTC's procurement policy and the works will be programmed to follow.

4.4 <u>Turf Club Pavilion – Valuation / Lease progress</u>: Question as to whether valuation had occurred yet. Taken on notice.

4.5 <u>Mesh Bins for CDS recyclables</u>: Currently stored in a Show Society Pavilion. Agreed that they would be made available for the Race meeting.

5.1 <u>Norforce Pavilion</u>:

• Reported that there had been some damage to the front facia of the building – to the left had side of the front roller door. Possible break-in attempt.

7.1 <u>Rear Gate Access – Manual lock combination</u>:

Question was raised as to whether the combination lock code has been changed. Yes it has as every legitimate user / hirer will be given a gate code for their access. The manual combination code is for Council purposes and will not be given out as this results in sharing of the code.

7.2 Buntine Pavilion:

There is a spare roller door stored in the Pavilion. KTC will organise for it to be removed to the Council Depot.

7.3 Katherine Turf Club:

Katherine Race Day is 14 August – request for watering of the front lawn area to be switching off the Thursday night before the meeting. Toilets to be open and stocked. Policing of the second crossover of the track to be improved as evidence of vehicles crossing the track here following the show weekend.

7.4 Katherine Dirt Car Club:

A new perimeter fence has been installed. A new storage shed is scheduled to be erected in September. A secondary spectator fence will be installed as part of a donation. Query as to access arrangement to any toilet block when undertaking working bees in the showgrounds site. Need to arrange access to the nearby overflow camping area toilet block.

7.5 Katherine Show Society:

Reported that the Rodeo and Camp draft events held in conjunction with the annual Show went off really well and many favourable comments were received from competitors regarding the new facilities.

7.6 <u>Blue Eagle Muay ThaiTurf Club</u>:

Requested KTC to investigate flooding issues with the front left hand corner of the Norforce Pavilion. The building goes under water leading to losses of equipment stored inside.
